

Title	A journey to the King Narai's temple in Korat	
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Abstract

The ancient temple located within the Korat city wall is an architectural structure built during the reign of King Narai the Great. With its beauty and historical significance, the temple is a valuable cultural attraction. Therefore, we initiated the project “A Journey to King Narai’s Temple in Korat” to introduce this site to tourists visiting Nakhon Ratchasima. The objectives of this project are: 1) to practice reading, writing, and summarizing skills using mind maps. 2) to develop speaking skills by presenting tourist attractions in English. 3) to create a video introducing old temples from the Ayutthaya period, built during King Narai’s reign and located within the Korat city wall. The study methods include: 1) conducting research using documents and learning resources. 2) analyzing and summarizing information into a mind map. 3) translating content from Thai to English and checking for accuracy. 4) practicing speaking and presenting to teachers and classmates for evaluation. 5) editing video clips for online distribution. The results show that using mind maps improves memory retention of the content presented. Students were able to speak about the temples in English to peers and teachers, and successfully distributed their English-language introduction video through online platforms.
